


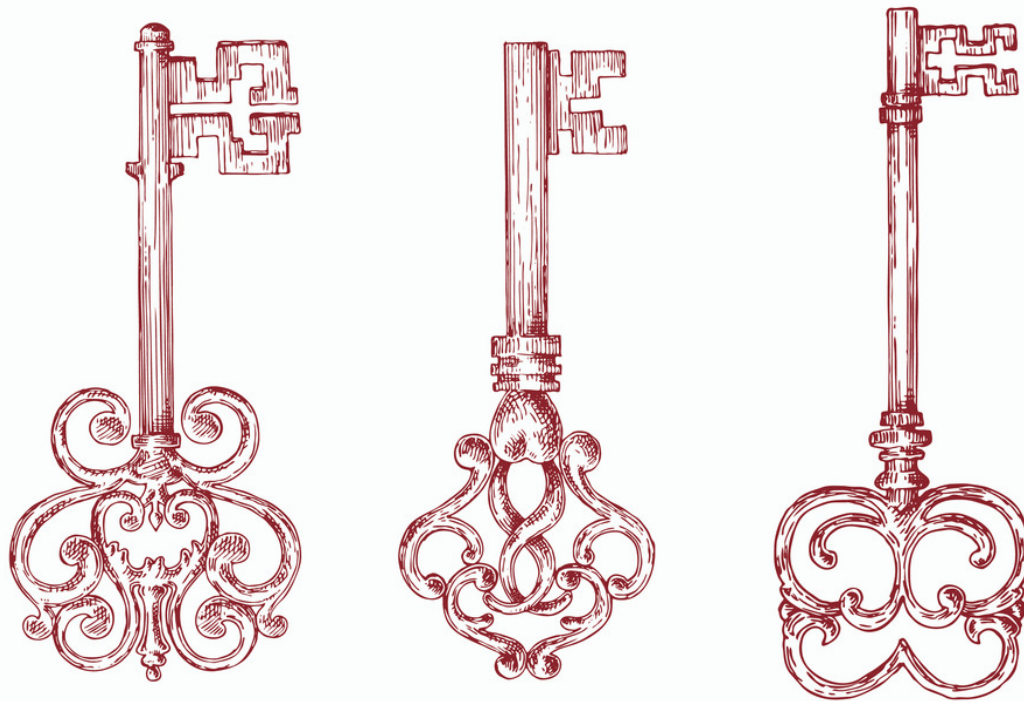

This will be an evening that the Townsfolk of Barlworth will always remember, they will never, ever forget the true story of Pennington Park!

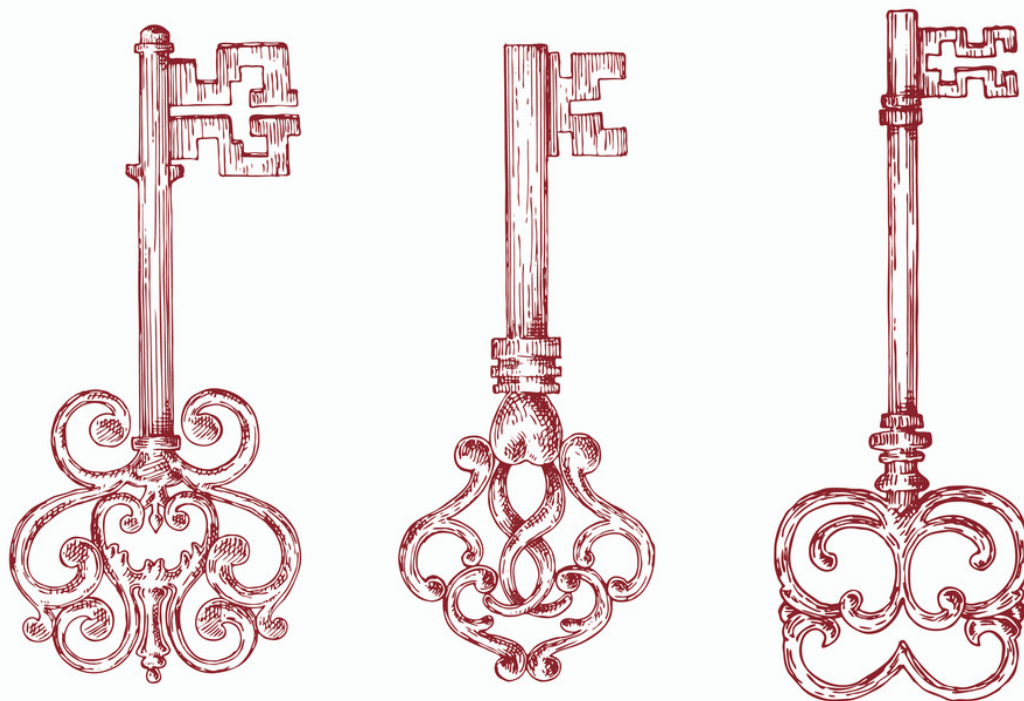
The Suspects

Transport and parking

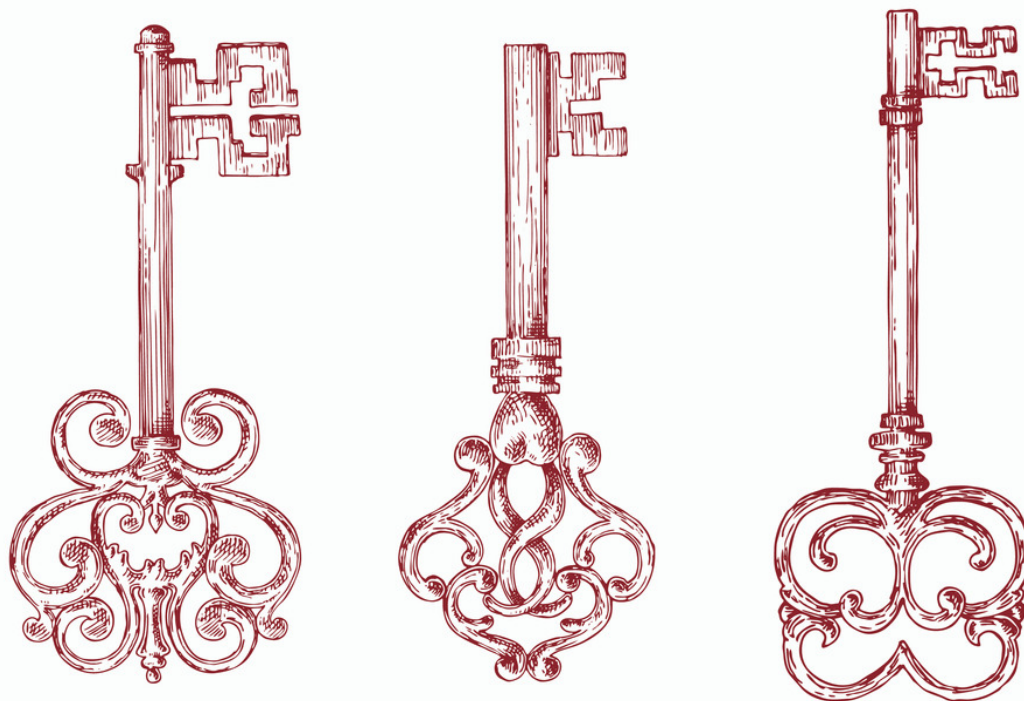

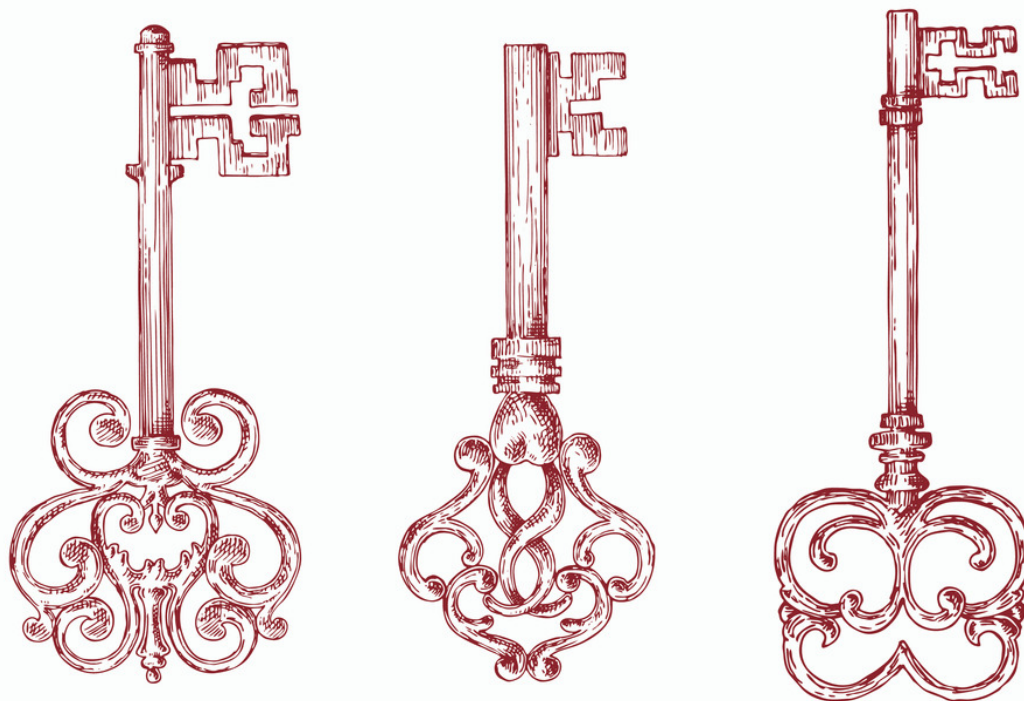
