Knot Garden

Why do you think this is called a knot garden? Can you find this pattern in the house?



Ground Floor Well

In this room you can see a well? Why is it here? How would you get water from it?



Ground Floor Reception Room

Look around, spot a small item and describe it to a friend. Can they see where it is?



First Floor Great Oak Room

How does this room make you feel? What can you see and smell?



Great Oak Room

Look at the ceiling, can you see a Tudor Rose? What else can you see above your head?



First Floor Bedroom

This room has an four-poster bed. Imagine what it would be like to sleep in this bed.



First Floor Print Room

What can you hear in this room and where do the sounds come from?



Mary Carpenter Room

This room was used for teaching girls in the 1800s. How does it compare with your classroom?
